

Race Day Info... VINE TO WINE 5K



PACKET PICK-UP

Packet Pick-Up is on **Sunday, June 26** from 8-8:45 AM and is located on the crush pad on the back side of the winery. Participants will pick up their bib number and event shirt at this time.

- **If you are not feeling well, please stay home.** This is an outdoor event with plenty of room to space you/your group 6 feet apart from others. Masks are not required for outdoor gatherings by the CDC; however, we encourage masks for unvaccinated people during packet pick-up, registration and at the race start.
- Your bib number will be emailed to you prior to race day, or you can go to your RunSignUp page to see it.
- There will be **2 LINES BY LAST NAME** to pick up your bib/shirt. **Bib numbers will be assigned on Friday.** If you register later than this, please go to the Race Day Registration line under the tent to pick up your race bib.
- We will be running, rain or shine! The race will be postponed to **Wednesday, June 29 at 6 PM ONLY IF** there is severe weather that makes the course unsafe for runners. We will notify you via email, website and Facebook.
- Race day registration is available from 8 AM-8:45 AM. Go to the Corkscrew Racing web page for more info.
- Bathrooms are located inside the winery on both the first and second floor.

PARKING

- Event parking is located next to the winery in the grass.

RACE START

- The start for the race is in the vineyard, and the finish line is down the driveway from the entrance into Barren Ridge. Race start is 9:00 AM.
- The race is chip timed, allowing you to spread out while lining up; your time does not begin until you cross the start line.
- Pin your bib to the front of your shirt or shorts – bib should be visible at the start and finish.
- If you have a stroller or a dog, please start behind all runners and walkers.
- Participants with doggos...keep Fido leashed and close to you at all times, especially on the course to prevent any mishaps with other runners.
- **BYOW...bring your own water!** As a green initiative, we will not be providing water on the course. A water bottle refilling station will be near the finish.

COURSE INFO

- The course is OPEN to traffic...please run against traffic and cross roads with caution.
- The course will be marked with white arrows on pavement, and blue arrows on orange cones.
- The course is mostly pavement with a few rolling hills.
- Please bring enough water to properly rehydrate.
- Course directions: The course starts in the vineyard behind the winery. Follow the driveway and make a left onto Barren Ridge Rd. Go 1.5 miles, to the turnaround and retrace your steps back to the vineyard.
- Cross the finish line ONCE. Please move away from the finish line to allow others to cross the line safely.

POST-RACE PARTY

- Outdoor and indoor seating is available on a first come, first serve basis; however, we encourage everyone to bring picnic blankets and chairs to enjoy the post-race party.
- Your finisher glass and wine tasting will be available for redemption in 2 locations on the crush pad. Please have your beverage ticket ready...it's attached to your bib.
- Additional wine and snacks may be purchased from the tasting room; please bring your ID.
- Food will be available for purchase from El Chilango Mexican Grill, beginning at 9 AM.
- Be sure to visit the Public Lands tent, event sponsor for the Vine to Wine 5K.
- The awards ceremony will be at 10:30 AM. Awards will be given to the overall male and female finishers, to the 1st place age group winners, and to the biggest team. Winners must be present to receive their award.
